

Student Travel Support:

NSF/DARPA funds will be used to provide travel support (in the range of \$300 - \$500 per applicant- depending on the number of applicants), toward defraying the costs of registration, subsistence and travel.

The support from the NSF/DARPA funds will be sufficient to cover registration and a portion of travel. This program reduces the costs, to the selected students, to a very modest level. This enables promising students to attend the conference and become more integrated into their scientific community.

Eligibility and Requirements

Eligibility:

- At the time of application, the student must be enrolled at an institution of higher learning in the United States.
- The student must be in good standing and do research in wireless sensor networks.
- The student will register for the IPSN'04.

To apply, the student and his/her advisor must provide the following information to Xenofon Koutsoukos , the finance chair of the 2003 IPSN'04. His e-mail address is Xenofon.Koutsoukos@vanderbilt.edu.

Requirements:

 2. Institutional Address

 4. Advisor's Name

 6. Amount of support requested (actual support will depend on the number of applicants and funds available)
 7. A paragraph of justification for the request of financial support
- Provided by Advisor

An email of certification and support from student's academic advisor, stating that he/she is currently enrolled as a student and is working on wireless sensor networks.

Deadline: March 19, 2004. This deadline applies to students and to their advisors, both need to submit letters.
